



# **CPC10111 CERTIFICATE I IN CONSTRUCTION**

#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

The CPC10111 Certificate I in Construction qualification provides an introduction to the construction industry, its culture, occupations, job roles and workplace expectations. Master Plumbers Association of South Australia Inc (MPASA) delivers this qualification with a plumbing industry focus. The purpose of this course is to enable learners to develop skills and knowledge that improve their employability and work readiness.

# **COURSE DURATION**

This qualification is delivered over a full school year period (one day per week) and may also include work placement.

### **COURSE DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT**

This course is delivered face to face, using theory and practical assessments tools. This course will be delivered using a real-life simulated workplace environment. Work Placement is a highly recommended component of this qualification.

# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To undertake our CPC10111 Certificate I in Construction program, students must:

- Be currently enrolled as a secondary school student (Year 10, 11 or 12)
- · Hold basic language, literacy and numeracy skills
- Be physically able to undertake practical task assessments (using tools and equipment)

Master Plumbers Association of SA Inc will conduct a pre-enrolment Assessment to ensure students hold the required Language, Literacy and Numeracy skills to successfully complete the course. Additional student support arrangements may be implemented where necessary.
